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

- The Glenturret Distillery, Scotland's oldest working distillery on the banks of the River Turret in a secluded Highland glen, now home to the Michelinstarred Lalique Restaurant, and just 40 minutes' drive from Dun Aluinn.

## Itinerary

#### DAY 1

## **Arrival at Dun Aluinn**

 You will be met at Edinburgh or Glasgow Airport by your driver for your transfer to Dun Aluinn. The journey, which passes through some of the Highlands' most spectacular scenery, takes under two hours. Alternative transfers can also be arranged depending on your location. The Caledonian Sleeper from London stops at Dunkeld, the nearest train station to Aberfeldy.

#### **Dinner at Dewars Distillery**

- Dewars Distillery, which was founded in 1898, is just a short walk from Dun Aluinn. Guests will be greeted by a bagpiper at the entrance of the distillery for an exclusive private dinner in the museum, followed by a rare whisky tasting in the Secret Room, buried deep within the distillery.
- Have you ever been curious about the skills needed to become a Master Blender? You will learn about the different flavour profiles and how Master Blenders create complexity and consistency. You will then create your own Blended Scotch Whisky to take home.





## **ITINERARY**

#### DAY 2

#### **Breakfast**

• Enjoy a seasonally inspired breakfast by Ballintaggart Farm.

#### Visit to Blair Athol Distillery

• An in-depth tour of the distillery followed by a tutored tasting of five Blair Athol single malts, including one drawn straight from the cask and the 23 year-old. Following the tasting you will retire to the Mash Tun Bar, where you will sample specifically tailored to your chosen flavour profiles.

#### **Private Tour of Blair Castle**

- A light lunch at the white turreted fairytale castle will be followed by a private tour. Blair Castle has been, home to the Atholl family for over seven centuries.
- Back at Dun Aluinn wander into the town to explore its cosy cafes, award-winning bookshop and independent stores.

#### Candlelit Haunted Castle Tour and Dinner at Castle Menzies

 After darkness falls, travel to Castle Menzies where a professional storyteller will lead you by candlelight through this forbidding fortress, weaving tales of its dark history and the spirits still said to prowl its dimly lit corridors. After the tour dinner in front of the ancient kitchen's roaring fire will help cast off the chill followed by a warming dram, a whisky tasting in the castle's jail led by Maclean and Bruce.

#### DAY 3

#### **Breakfast**

After a hearty breakfast, enjoy a guided walk, to the famous Birks of Aberfeldy.
On Dun Aluinn's doorstep, the spectacular waterfall walk was immortalised by
Scotland's most famous poet, Robert Burns and his statue can be seen looking
out over the gorge.

### Visit to Glenturret Distillery

- Depart mid afternoon for a very special evening and private dining experience at the Michelin starred Lalique Restaurant within Scotland's oldest distillery.
- Private Whisky Maker's Tour The Glenturret Tour is a journey through the distillery's long and remarkable history. It explains the whisky making process and why, at Glenturret they embrace the ethos 'by hand and heart'. You will create your own whisky miniature to take home and after the tour sample a range of rare 30 year-old malts in the private tasting room.

## Dinner at the Michelin-starred Lalique Restaurant

• The exclusive and intimate restaurant overlooks the old still houses and tumbling waters of the River Turret. Highly creative eclectic dishes make up a cosmopolitan multi-course tasting menu. The restaurant will be exclusively yours for the evening.

#### **Breakfast**

- Breakfast by Ballintaggart Farm.
- There is the option for a local guided walk after breakfast or the chance to experience one of Dunn Aluinn's tailored Highland Experiences, such as fishing or canoeing.
